

CITY OFFICES CLOSED TO PUBLIC ACCESS

UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE DUE TO COVID-19 CONCERNS

The City of Caldwell is closely monitoring information provided by Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Texas Department of State Health Services (Texas DSHS), and decisions made by our partners at Burleson County, Caldwell ISD, and other agencies. As more information becomes available and the local impact changes, the City of Caldwell along with community leaders remain vigilant to make the appropriate decisions to safeguard the public in an abundance of caution.

Currently, there are no confirmed cases of coronavirus (COVID-19) in our community or the county, and we encourage members of the public not to panic. Essential city services will continue to be provided. It is important that precautionary measures are being taken to prepare and mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus. During this unprecedented time, the City of Caldwell urges everyone to participate in keeping our community healthy by following the CDC and Texas DSHS guidelines for preventing the spread of COVID-19 and other illnesses.
